- 7. That the school shall strictly abide by the provisions of Delhi School Education Act & Rules, 1973 and payment will be made as per section 10(1) of Delhi School Education Act, 1973 read with 126 of the Rules to all the employees by crossed cheque.
- 8. That the enrolment in each section shall not exceed the number of students calculated @ 10 sq.ft. per student for the available floor area of the classroom and the school shall provide adequate and sufficient accommodation as per the norms of the Directorate of Education, Delhi in each class.
- That the school shall dispense with the services of unqualified and over-aged staff, if any, immediately.
- 10. That the Govt. nominees on the Managing Committee to be constituted as per the approved scheme will be asked for immediately.
- The Managing Committee of the school shall not enhance the fee during the ensuing academic session without the prior approval of the Director of Education.
