Eligibility Criterion

- ❖ Please note that in order to be considered for admission to Cambridge, applicants from India must normally either be potential affiliated students (i.e. applying to study for a second Bachelors degree) or studying for the International Bacculaureate or A Levels
- ❖ Applications from students taking CBSE or ISC Class XII examinations will be considered but only for the following courses: Computer Science, Economics, Engineering, Mathematics, Natural Sciences. To be shortlisted for interview such applicants will need to have scored 96% or better in their Class X examinations. Any offers of admission made to such students will be conditional on performance in the IIT-JEE or, in the case of Economics or Mathematics, on performance in STEP Mathematics.
- ❖ English language requirements
If your first language is not English, please note that you will be required to achieve, before ultimate entry, a satisfactory standard in the IELTS International English Language Test taken through the British Council, normally achieving an overall score of at least 7.0 in each element of that test.

A reasonable standard in spoken English is also required at the time of interview, equivalent to about at least IELTS grade 6, and with additional knowledge of the technical vocabulary in English for relevant subject areas.
